To make themselves known to staff, parents and pupils

To demonstrate commitment to the school

To observe the operation of policies

To give active support to the activities of the school

Frequency of Visits:

All governors to make at least one visit each year during school time

Arranging and Planning a Visit:

Agree date and time with the Head

Clarify what you will do, when you will arrive and depart, who you will see.

Arrange to meet with the Head at the end of the visit

Recording a visit

A record of the visit should be completed and given to the Head

The record will be stored in the "Governors' Visits" folder in the Head's office
